She is called “*a remarkable musician [with a] distinctive cello style.*” Virginia received her Bachelor’s in Music degree from University of Wisconsin, Madison in 1977; Master’s in Music from USC in 1979. She has studied with William Pleeth, Guy Fallot, Gabor Rejto, Lowell Creitz, and Nadene Bean. She has recorded with the Czech National Symphony; performed with the New West Symphony, Boris Brott conducting, in the premier of “Concerto for Cello and Chamber Orchestra” by John Biggs; and in festivals nationwide. Her instrument is a 1691 Giovanni Grancino. Virginia knew early on that the cello would be her life. Classically trained, she finds herself drawn to the music of our time and finds herself responding to it as powerfully as to the beloved classics. Virginia’s vivacious demeanor and superb musicianship have endeared her to audiences and critics alike. Please reserve your seat now!
