## Yes, you may:

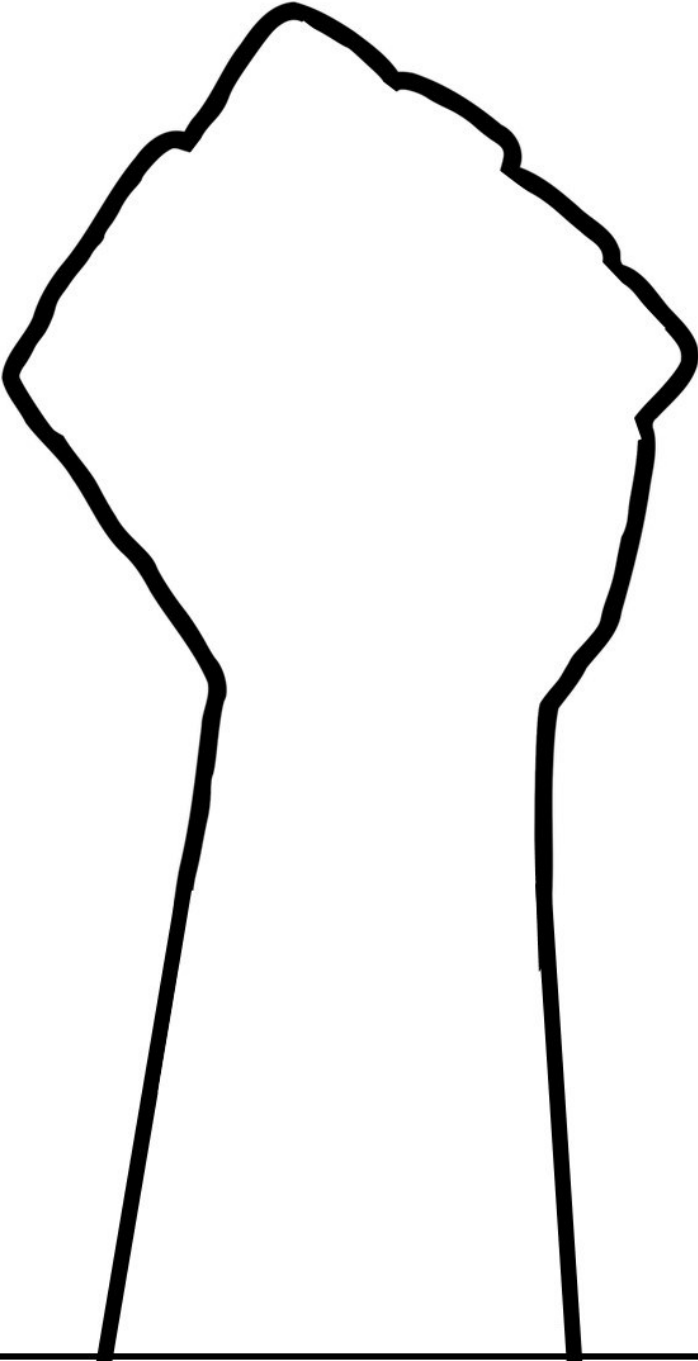
- Use any medium you like.
